1 Printing

Instructions for printing session results

Overview

Version 1.6.1 of the iResponse Pro Utility (PC and Mac) now provides the ability to print the results of the iResponse session.

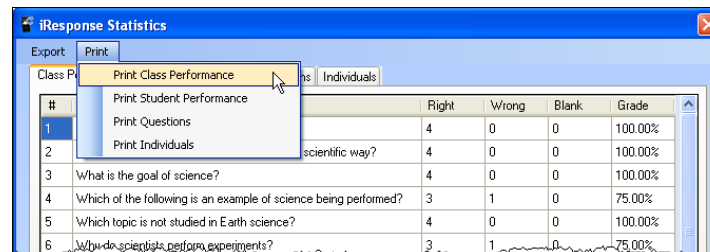
The pre-formatted print options include:

- Class Performance
- Student Performance
- Individual Response sorted by Question
- Individual Response sorted by Individual

Class Performance

Prints the class performance by question in an ordered list displaying the number of correct responses, incorrect responses, and blank responses.

Select Print - Print Class Performance to print with the default printer.

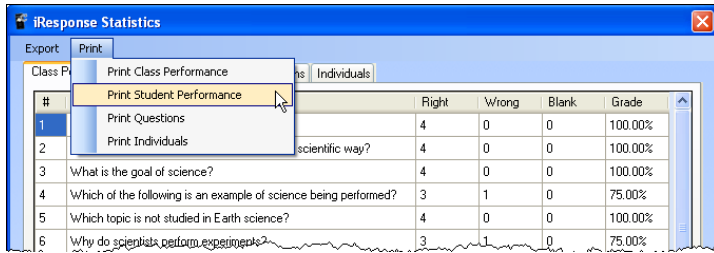

Student Performance

Prints the student's performance in an ordered list displaying the number of correct responses, incorrect responses, blank responses and the participant's grade.

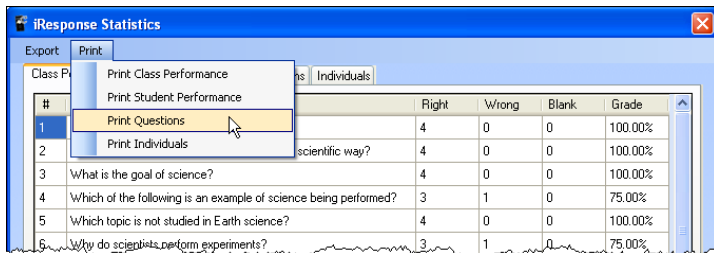
Select Print - Print Student Performance to print with the default printer.



Questions

Prints the individual student's response by question in an ordered list displaying each student's response to the questions.

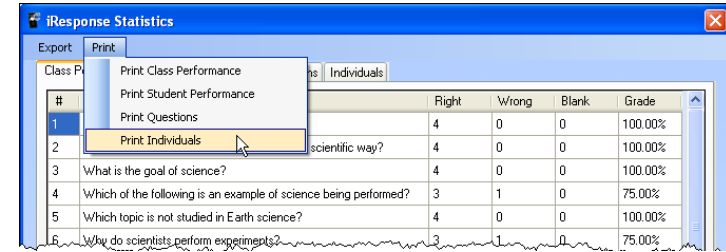
Select Print - Print Questions to print with the default printer.



Individual

Prints the individual student's response for each question by individual in an ordered list displaying the each student's response to the questions.

Select Print - Print Individual to print with the default printer.



2 Saving a Session

Instructions for saving a session

Overview

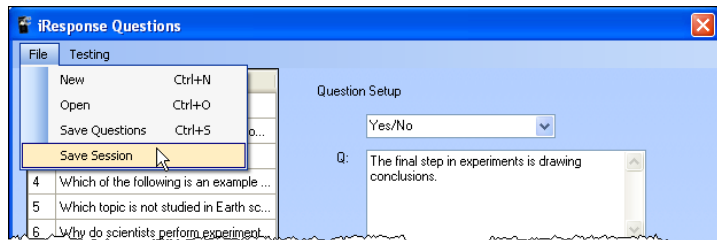
Version 1.6.1 of the iResponse Pro Utility (PC and Mac) now provides the ability to save a complete session.

Saving a session to view the session data at a later date and time, including:

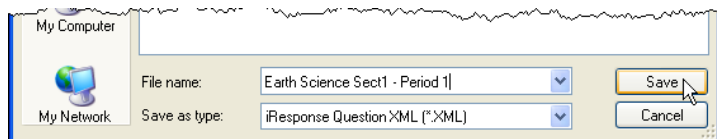
- Questions transmitted
- Individual responses, including graph display of responses
- All export options
- All print options

Saving a session

Select File - Save Session to save all the data associated with an iResponse session.



Note- Ensure the saved session has a unique file name. This will allow the user to differentiate between saved questions / tests and saved sessions.



Open a session

Select File - Open to open and view the saved session data.
